**FINDINGS AND ORDER**

The above-entitled matter came on for final default hearing before the Honorable Kevin S. Petitioner was present and represented by Barna, Guzy & Steffen, Ltd., by Elizabeth A. Schading, Esq. Respondent was not present.

Now therefore, based upon all the files and pleadings:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**


1. Respondent cannot be located.
2. The Summons was published one time per week for three weeks in the Champlin-Dayton Press, from July 7, 2011 until July 21, 2011. There was no response from Respondent.
3. It is unlikely that publication of the notice of entry of the decree will be seen by Respondent.

**ORDER**

As an alternative to newspaper publication of the notice of entry of the decree, Petitioner shall for 30 days post on her Facebook page a notice that the dissolution of marriage decree was entered in Hennepin County and Respondent or anyone knowing of his whereabouts should contact Petitioner. If Respondent's location is revealed, Petitioner's counsel shall serve him notice of entry of the decree by United States Mail. Such notice shall be good and proper for all purposes. If Respondent's location remains unknown, the Facebook posting shall serve and good and proper service for all purposes.
